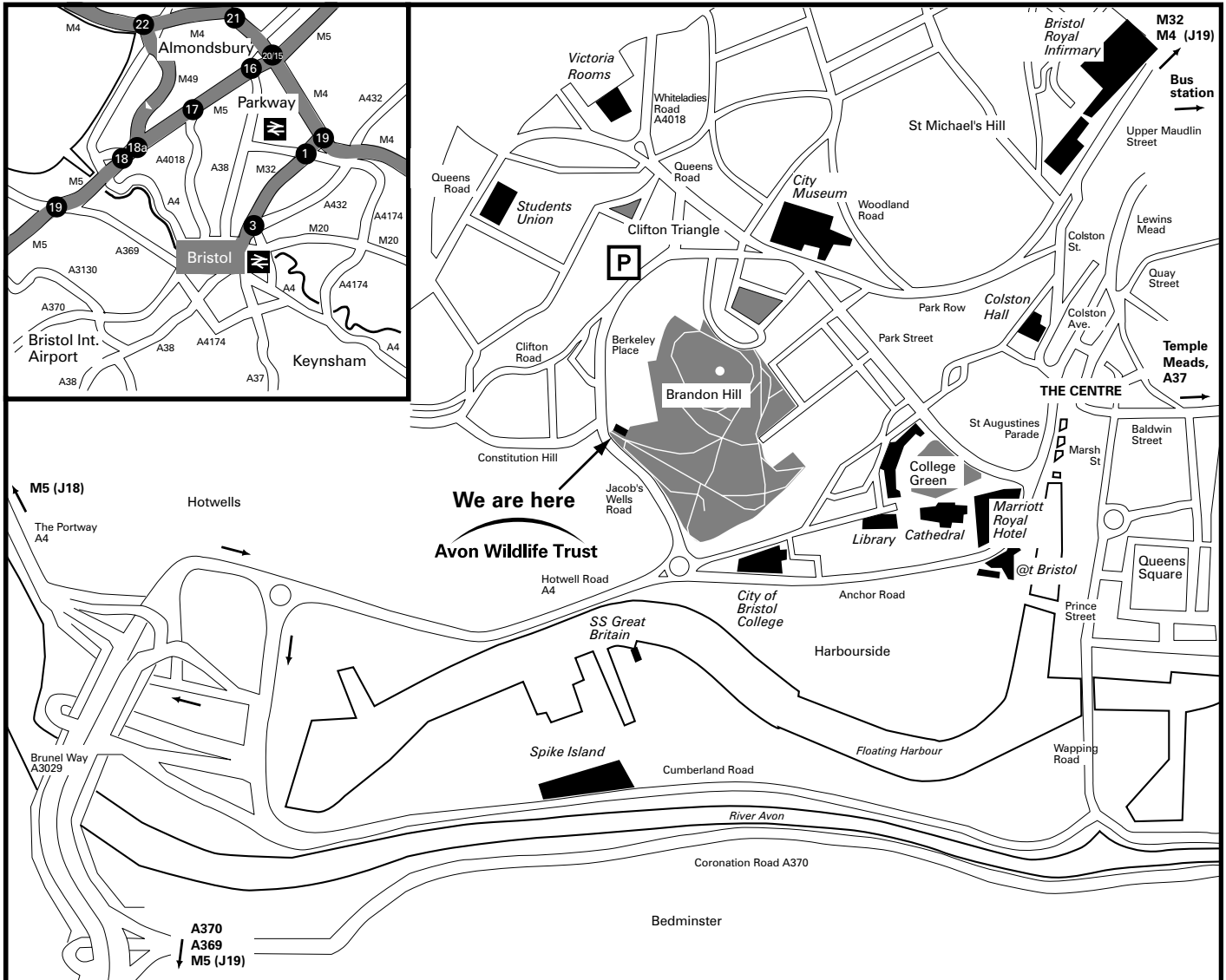

### On foot

The Trust Office is halfway along Jacobs Wells Road, about one mile west of the City Centre, almost next to the Hope & Anchor pub and opposite the Constitution Hill turning. Access to the Trust Office is up a flight of stone steps from the pavement, leading into Brandon Hill park.

### By bike

Make your way to the Trust Office (as above). There are cycle racks in the courtyard of the Trust office.

### By wheelchair

Regrettably access to the Trust Office by wheelchair is extremely difficult because of the steep stone steps up to the building from the pavement. Flat but much longer routes are available through Brandon Hill park from the east.

### By rail

Bristol is served by two main-line stations – Temple Meads, just east of the city centre, and Parkway out towards the M4/M5 intersection. For train times, visit [www.trainline.co.uk](http://www.trainline.co.uk) or phone National Rail Enquiries on 08457 484950.

*Temple Meads* is about 30 minutes' walk from the Trust Office; or by taxi or bus (see below).

*Parkway* is about 7 miles from the Trust Office; or by bus to the city centre (routes 73 or X84).

### By bus

Routes 8 and 9 run from Temple Meads to Clifton Triangle at the northern end of Jacobs Wells Road, while route 500 follows a circular route every 30 minutes to the southern end of Jacobs Wells Road. Routes 1, 8, 9, 41, 42, 43, 44, 54 and 55 run from the city centre to Clifton Triangle.

### By coach

Many long-distance bus/coach services run to Bristol Bus & Coach Station just north of 'The Centre'. Bus routes to the Trust office as above.

### By road

Bristol is at the intersection of the M4 and M5 providing ready access from London, the Midlands, Wales and the South West. Take the following routes to the City Centre:

- M4 from east: at M4 junction 19, join M32
- M4/M49 from Wales and M5 from north: at M5 junction 18, take A4 along Portway and under the Clifton Suspension Bridge.
- M5 from South: at M5 junction 19, join A369.

There is a multi-storey car park at the top end of Jacobs Wells Road. Street parking is not advised unless you know Bristol well.
