

## Wildlife Action Group information

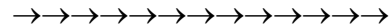
No need to book (unless specified on the task list).

Please bring:

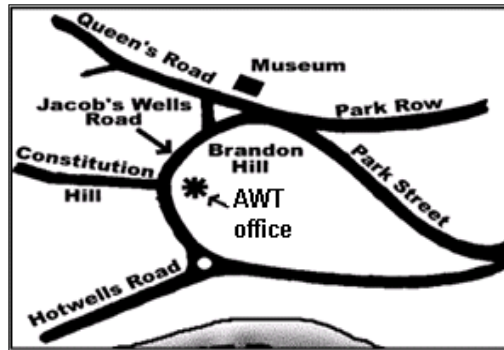
- A packed lunch

## Wednesdays (Depart 10am)

### January

8<sup>th</sup> **Burledge Hill**

Scrub clearance on the SSSI.

15<sup>th</sup> **Tickenham Hill**

Scrub clearance on the top of the site.

22<sup>nd</sup> **Folly Farm**

We will be continuing to clear scrub in North Hill.

29<sup>th</sup> **Bathampton Meadow**

The back of the oxbow is getting a bit overgrown so we will be cutting back bramble

### February

5<sup>th</sup> **Tickenham Hill**

Scrub clearance on the top of the site.

12<sup>th</sup> **Kings Wood**

Following thinning in previous years the woodland has opened up nicely, and we will be laying hazel to encourage it to spread across the woodland floor a bit more.

19<sup>th</sup> **Priors Wood**

There is still some rhododendron left to clear down at Bullocks Bottom, so we will be finishing this off.

26<sup>th</sup> **Clapton Moor**

Clearing back vegetation around the old fence line so we can remove the final bits of fencing wire in the meadows.

### March

4<sup>th</sup> **Burledge Hill**

Scrub clearance on the SSSI.

11<sup>th</sup> **Folly Farm**

Continuing with our scrub clearance work on the SSSI.

18<sup>th</sup> **Hellenge Hill**

As spring starts to appear on the horizon we will be clearing low lying scrub at Hellenge.

25<sup>th</sup> **Mystery Task**

We will keep this day free to see what tasks come up as we progress through winter works.
