The Pondside Canvas

Capacity: 20 people Dimensions: 10m x 7m

This open air space, with a graceful wooden arch was built with access and freedom in mind.

A versatile area for larger events including parties, films or talks.



Inside the Pondside Canvas

Underneath the large roof, you will be protected from the weather whether that be driving rain or hot sun.

Tables and chairs can be provided to allow you to use the space exactly how you desire – just let us know your requirements.



The Pod

Capacity: 15 people Dimensions: 10m x 8m

This beautiful structure was lovingly converted from an old polytunnel and was hand-built for optimal access and light.

The two large doors on either end of the tunnel allow you to control how open the space feels, making it an ideal place to use the whole year round.

Inside The Pod

Tables and chairs can be provided and rearranged to suit your needs.

There is an electric point provided meaning electronic devices can be used. There is also overhead lighting ensuring the space can be used after dark.



The Roundhouse

Capacity: 7 people Dimensions: 6m diameter

This unique, straw bale construction with a living roof was built with intimacy and sharing in mind.

Complete with log burner and festooned with fairy lights, the Roundhouse comes into it's own as a sanctuary against the outside world.



Inside the Roundhouse

Benches are built into the walls providing a natural circle for your group.

Alternatively, chairs can be provided and arranged on our unique wood log flooring.

Doors and a windows can also be opened to provide a more open and airy space.



The Classroom

Capacity: 12 people Dimensions: 7m x 6m

Located in our main building onsite. This indoor room is ideal for classes, work meetings and workshops. A functional area complete with power sockets, whiteboard, Wi-Fi and projector (optional).



Inside the Classroom

Tables and chairs can be provided and rearranged to your requirements.

The space is heated during the colder months and is well lighted.

The Willow Circle

Further information:

- Access to the communal kitchen onsite is included with all bookings. This includes access to hot water, tea, coffee, a microwave, plates and cutlery.
- If you wish to self-cater and require a space to prepare and/or serve food from, our outdoor kitchen can be hired at the same rate as a normal space.
- We are happy to promote your courses or activities on our social media for no extra charge. If you put together an Eventbrite or facebook event with clear booking information leading to you to take booking, we can advertise your course on our facebook page.

Terms & Conditions

- To secure a date, full payment is required in advance. If a large event, 40% of the value is required to secure your booking.
- Payments and deposits are non-refundable within two weeks of the booking date. If an event
 requires cancellation as a direct result of changing government guidelines in respect of Coronavirus,
 a full refund can be issued or the date of the event can be rescheduled.
- Small event refundable deposit of £40 for cleaning or damage.
- Large event refundable deposit of £150 for cleaning or damage.
- You must complete and sign a site hire induction before using a space.
- You are responsible for your group's behaviour, health and safety and first aid when on site. However, we are first aid qualified so please inform us if on site. All incidents or near misses must be reported to us within 24 hours.
- It is your responsibility to inform your group to stick to paths and not to play in flower beds or veg growing areas. We host six food growing businesses and manage a living seed bank on site so many of the areas are quite delicate. However, there are lots of paths to explore!
- Fires must be attended at all times. We do not allow candles to be used inside the buildings.
- Your space and the site must be returned to a clean and tidy area before leaving (this includes the kitchen and all washing up if used).
- Please take home any excess recycling and waste as we promote waste reduction across Avon Wildlife Trust, especially unnecessary plastic usage.
- The Communal Kitchen is currently out of bounds to external visitors. If desired, an urn can be provided for hot water.
- You are welcome to bring your own wood to use in the burners or on the fire; wood cannot be harvested from our woodland areas as it is intended for our habitats.
- Any individual item breakages must be covered.
- If it is necessary for you to cancel or postpone your booking, please inform AWT in writing as soon
 as possible. Cancellation is effective from the date your letter/email is received at our offices, and
 may be subject to cancellation charges as follows:
- The deposit is automatically forfeited if the booking is cancelled by the client for any reason except to meet Covid-19 Government guidance
- If cancellation is made less than 28 days before the commencement of the course, whether
 deliberately or by default, the balance of fees must be paid in full, a condition that is accepted when
 the booking is confirmed, except if the cancellation is to meet Covid-19 Government guidance
- Due to the Covid-19 pandemic we have suspended our cancellation charges for schools who need
 to cancel their visit in order to meet Covid-19 Government guidance. Please contact us with as much
 notice as possible so that we can offer the dates to others. You can choose to reschedule to a future
 date (subject to availability), receive a credit note, or receive a full refund.
- It is strongly recommended that travel and cancellation insurance is obtained for the group as would be standard for any "out of school/college" trip, course or holiday.

If a ticketed event, you must:

- Complete a temporary events notice if providing live music/performances and bar as part of the event.
- Complete an onsite induction.
- · Provide an events risk assessment.
- Provide insurance details.
- Pay £150 returnable deposit after event for clean-up and damages.
