Pledge 30% of your outdoor space to wildlife

Give your time to help local wildlife

Bring together people in your local area to create a community action group for wildlife

Switch to buying organic produce where possible

8

Join forces with colleagues to do something for wildlife in your work-place

9

Buy local produce where possible

10

Switch to a renewable energy provider

11

Reduce your use of plastic by at least 30%

12

Create a wildlife pond to attract more insects, birds and mammals to your local area

13

Reduce your meat consumption by at least 30%

Build a bee hotel to help solitary bees

15

Pick-up 30 pieces of litter

Get involved in a local community project

Buy 30 wildflowers to plant for pollinators

Build a bird box to give more space for birds to nest in your local area

Become an Avon Wildlife Trust member from £3 a month

Record 30 species on iNaturalist to help monitor local wildlife levels

Go peat free to help protect our internationally rare peatland habitat

Buy nothing new for 30 days
