

Bath Half Marathon - Sunday 16 October 2022

Terms and conditions

1. You must be at least 17 years old on the day of the event to take part.
2. You participate in the Bath Half Marathon at your own risk and Avon Wildlife Trust shall not be liable for any accident or loss incurred as a result of your participation in the event. It is your responsibility to train adequately for the event and to consult your doctor if you have any concerns about your ability to complete the event safely.
3. You acknowledge the registration fee you have paid is non-refundable and cannot be used towards your sponsorship pledge.
4. If you are successful in your application for a Avon Wildlife Trust charity place, please note this place is non-transferable.
5. You acknowledge this is a fundraising event and commit to raise the minimum sponsorship pledge of £300 excluding any Gift Aid or employer match giving.
6. When fundraising, you will act lawfully and follow the fundraising guidelines provided by the Avon Wildlife Trust. You must make it clear you are fundraising "in aid of Avon Wildlife Trust" and are not representing on behalf of Avon Wildlife Trust. You must not do anything that may harm the reputation of Avon Wildlife Trust or act in a manner contrary to our values.
7. For any independent fundraising events that you carry out to raise funds (for example a cake sale or pub quiz), you acknowledge that you are carrying such events out in your own capacity. It's your responsibility to organise all aspects of such event and make it clear that such event is run by you "in aid of" Avon Wildlife Trust and is not run by Avon Wildlife Trust. You also agree to make it clear that such event is not "on behalf of Avon Wildlife Trust" and that Avon Wildlife Trust cannot accept any responsibility or liability for such event. If you wish to use Avon Wildlife Trust's logo, please contact the Avon Wildlife Trust fundraising team who can provide our "in aid of" logo.
8. You agree to secure a licence from the relevant local authority before collecting funds on the street or in a public place. You acknowledge you are responsible for obtaining any such licence and informing the Avon

Wildlife Trust fundraising team who can provide guidance.

9. Your fundraising must be paid into Avon Wildlife Trust at least one month after the event.
10. If you have to withdraw prior to the event, you must notify Avon Wildlife Trust immediately and before the registration deadline if possible. This means we can re-allocate your place to someone else. Any money raised will be retained as a donation towards Avon Wildlife Trust. If you wish to refund your donors in this instance, you must ask your individual donors to make a written request to Avon Wildlife Trust, as they will be refunded directly.
11. You agree that Avon Wildlife Trust can use any photographs taken of you at the event in any literature, publicity, information material or publication promoting the work of Avon Wildlife Trust. This may include brochures, posters, leaflets, display boards, Avon Wildlife Trust website, Avon Wildlife Trust social media platform and any other appropriate materials.
12. It is your responsibility to cover any costs incurred to attend the event.
