Did you know that there is a secret place full of nature, right here in Stockwood?

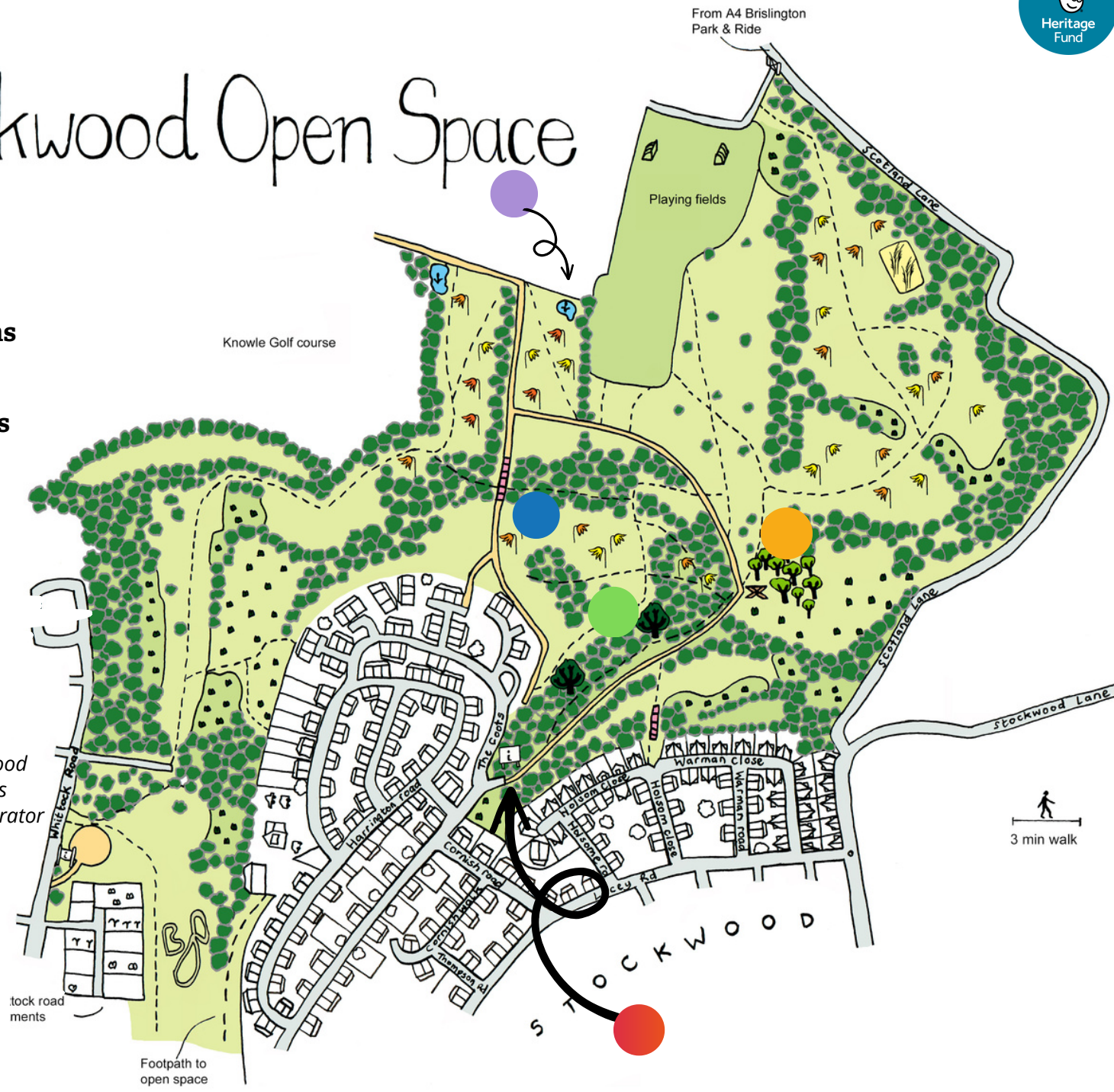
We love it there and so will you! All you need are wellies or boots and a sense of adventure!
